Lazarus Group Targeting Defense Experts with Fake Interviews via Trojanized VNC Apps

Over the past month, there has been an observed shift in the tactics employed by the Lazarus group, a North Korean hacker group renowned for its focus on the chemical sector, notably during Operation Dream Job. The group has now started incorporating Virtual Network Computing (VNC) tactics to entice job seekers. This involves encouraging targets to open applications, which install malware designed for both espionage and financial theft.

Storm-1133 Used in Attacks Against Israel and Organizations Hostile to Hamas

The *Microsoft Digital Defense Report* of October 2023 has identified Storm-1133 as an emerging threat associated with Hamas. This threat cluster has been deployed against the Israeli defense, energy, and telecommunication sectors. While its primary focus is on third parties with Israeli connections, Microsoft has highlighted that Storm-1133 employs new techniques to delay detection. Furthermore, it is being utilized in coordination with a growing trend of human-operated ransomware attacks.

Testing of soil and groundwater in Darlington County showed that hundreds of acres of farmland have been polluted by chemicals. A cause for such a level of chemical pollution is that some farmers were given sewer sludge as fertilizer a few years ago. The US Department of Defense has notified more than 190 farms within a mile of military installations that they are at risk from chemicals found on the military sites. There are no current plans to limit forever chemicals in sewer sludge.
